# **PY 2020 Supportive Housing Program Implementation Training**

On December 15, 2020, OCD will host the Supportive Housing Program grant implementation training. This training is **required** for grantees who received funding through the Round 1 Homeless Crisis Response Program ESG-CV CARES Act Program and PY 2020 Supportive Housing and Homeless Crisis Response Programs (grants beginning January 1, 2021). The registration deadline was yesterday, however attendees can still register <u>here</u>.

#### PY 2020 Critical Infrastructure Program Round 2

Eligible applicants interested in applying for Round 2 PY 2020 Critical Infrastructure Program funding are required to submit a pre-application to OCD for review by **Wednesday, December 16, 2020**. Upon approval, OCD will open a full application for the applicant in OCEAN to submit by **January 13, 2021**. OCD will accept pre-applications on a rolling basis and will consider new requests until all available PY 2020 funds are expended. To access the pre-application, click <u>here</u>.
