Changes to the Office of Community Development

Development's Community Services Division created two new offices in response to an influx of COVID-19 federal relief funds and a shift in responsibility: the Office of Division Support and the Office of Energy and Environment.

The Office of Division Support now includes OCD's Training and Technical Assistance staff as the Compliance section. The new section includes both compliance staff from the Offices of Community Assistance and Community Development. The Compliance staff will perform all the same duties for OCD grantees.

The Office of Energy and Environment will be responsible for the weatherization and energy programs and the newly created Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Program and upcoming brownfield and demolition programs.

Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant Program

Governor Mike DeWine announced the launch of the Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant program to help fund important water and wastewater infrastructure projects throughout Ohio. The program will provide nearly \$250 million in grant funding to Ohio communities. Grant Programs to Help Small and Medium-sized Businesses

Ohio Governor Mike DeWine and Lt. Governor Jon Husted announced four grant programs to help small and medium-sized businesses recover from the impact of the coronavirus pandemic. The programs will provide \$155 million in grant funding to businesses that opened in 2020, food

and beverage establishments, entertainment venues, and lodging venues. The funds were made available by the Ohio General Assembly as part of Senate Bill 108 and Senate Bill 109 in May.

All four programs will be administered by the Ohio Department of Development. Program guidelines, terms and conditions, and required documentation for all four programs are available now at https://businesshelp.ohio.gov/. Ohio Small Business Development Centers and Ohio Minority Business Assistance Centers are staffed with advisors who can help businesses with the application process. The four programs are:

- Food and Beverage Establishment Grant
- Entertainment Venue Grant
- Lodging Grant
- New Small Business Grant
