Limited PPE available through the Ohio Department of Public Safety

The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS) has a limited quantity of personal protective equipment (PPE) available to communities and nonprofit organizations. To request PPE, email esf6@dps.ohio.gov with the following information:

- Type and quantity of PPE requested
- Contact information
 - Names of your organization's contact person. (ODPS suggests multiple contacts)
 - Contact(s) phone number or e-mail address
 - Organization's hours of operation and any special delivery instructions
 - Date and time of pick up or delivery
 - For PPE deliveries, answer the following questions:
 - Is there a loading ramp at the delivery location?
 - Does the delivery location have personnel to unload the PPE?
 - Does the delivery location have equipment to unload the PPE?
