# **Contract Activity and Labor Standards Reporting**

For the reporting period April 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021, grantees must enter Notice of Contract Award (NOCA) data in OCEAN and submit Semi-Annual Labor Standards Enforcement Report (SALSER) forms via email to Sheilah Bradshaw by **Thursday, September 30, 2021**. ## **Secure Document Upload in OCEAN**

In June, the Office of Community Development (OCD) notified grantees that a new feature and role would be available in OCEAN that would allow grantees to send and receive documents to and from OCD. The file upload feature could be used for grant administration and remote monitoring.

In preparation for this new feature, <u>all</u> organizations must have a Data Confidentiality Agreement and updated Users & Roles form on file for any user who will upload files to the system. Each organization's Organization Edit User(s) received an email requesting the updated form be completed and returned by **September 1, 2021.**

## Change to HOME-funded Housing Set Up in OCEAN

Due to a new HUD reporting requirement, grantees that received HOME funds must enter the HOME Written Agreement date when setting up a new housing site address in OCEAN. OCD added a field under the *Attachments* section of the Housing Site Address page for the required date. Any addresses currently not in the completed status will need this date field completed by the grantee. Grantees will not be able to submit the address for approval (funding) without the HOME Written Agreement date. Grantees will need to ensure the date is correct: once entered it cannot be edited. ## PY 2018 and 2019 CHIP Program Project Limit Increase

Due to the current increase in construction materials, the Office of Community Development (OCD) revised the program activity limits for PY 2018 and PY 2019 CHIP Program grants. # **Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant Program**

Governor Mike DeWine announced the launch of the Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant program to help fund important water and wastewater infrastructure projects throughout Ohio. The program will provide nearly \$250 million in grant funding to Ohio communities. ## The State of Ohio Launches Four New Grant Programs

Ohio Governor Mike DeWine and Lt. Governor Jon Husted announced the launch of four grant programs to help small and medium-sized businesses recover from the impact of the coronavirus pandemic. The programs will provide \$155 million in grant funding to businesses

that opened in 2020, food and beverage establishments, entertainment venues, and lodging venues. The funds were made available by the Ohio General Assembly as part of Senate Bill 108 and Senate Bill 109 in May.

All four programs will be administered by the Ohio Department of Development, formally Ohio Development Services Agency. Program guidelines, terms and conditions, and required documentation for all four programs are available now at <a href="https://businesshelp.ohio.gov/">https://businesshelp.ohio.gov/</a>. Ohio Small Business Development Centers and Ohio Minority Business Assistance Centers are staffed with advisors who can help businesses with the application process. The four programs are:

- Food and Beverage Establishment Grant
- Entertainment Venue Grant
- Lodging Grant
- New Small Business Grant
