Citizen Participation Requirements for PY 2021

For all grantees applying for OCD grants in PY 2021, the citizen participation requirements are back to the 30-day minimum for public comment periods per HUD regulations. We encourage grantees to hold public hearings virtually, however, grantees must provide the community with reasonable notice and opportunity to comment. The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS) has a limited quantity of personal protective equipment (PPE) available to communities and nonprofit organizations. To request PPE, email esf6@dps.ohio.gov with the following information:

- Type and quantity of PPE requested
- Contact information
 - Names of your organization's contact person. (ODPS suggests multiple contacts)
 - Contact(s) phone number or e-mail address
 - Organization's hours of operation and any special delivery instructions
 - Date and time of pick up or delivery
 - For PPE deliveries, answer the following questions:
 - Is there a loading ramp at the delivery location?
 - Does the delivery location have personnel to unload the PPE?
 - Does the delivery location have equipment to unload the PPE?
