- The Setting (1972-74)
  - Richard Nixon & Gerald Ford were Presidents
  - George Romney & James Lynn were Secretaries of HUD
  - HUD Office of Metropolitan Development (Now CPD)
    - Eight Categorical Programs (Urban Renewal, Model Cities, Water & Sewer, Public Facilities, Open Space, Urban Beautification, Neighborhood Facilities)
    - Most Required Local Match (Cash & Non-Cash)
    - Separate Rules and Pots of \$\$\$
    - Competitive Each Year = Funding Uncertainty
    - Must Apply and Follow HUD Rules Including Grant Conditions
    - No Long-Term Planning



#### The Transition from Categorical to Block Grant (CDBG)

- Political Issues
  - Congress
  - Interest Groups (e.g., NAHRO, Housing, Public Works)
  - National Objectives: LMI, S&B, UN
  - LMI Emphasis (70% Primary Benefit Test)
- Funding Issues
  - What About Grantees with Large Amounts of Categorical Funding?
  - Answer: Hold Harmless Phase-In (Five Years)
- Restrictions
  - Limits on General Administration/Planning (20%), Public Services (15%) and New Housing Construction (CBDOs)
- Local Control vs. Federal Control (The Warren Butler Warning)





### The New World of CDBG

- Funding Certainty
- Two Programs: Small Cities (States) and Entitlements
- Long-Term Planning
- Broad Range of Activities
- Local Input and Control
- No Applications (Consolidated Plan)
- One Set of Program Rules (24 CFR Part 570)
- Minimal HUD Oversight
- Related Federal Requirements (e.g., OMB, NEPA, Uni Act, Davis-Bacon, FHEO)

#### Maintenance of Effort

Thou Shalt Not Use CDBG to **Supplant** Other Local Resources. CDBG Must **Supplement** Other Local Resources.

### Warm Margarine Approach

Too Many Grant Recipients Spread CDBG Around So Thinly that It Has No Meaningful Impact. Consider the NRSA Approach
