

Northside Redevelopment Project: PY 2022



Project Description:

- 4,527 feet of stormwater pipe replacement in backyards of private properties
- 32 catch basins
- 1,919 feet of street repaving
- 257 feet of waterline extensions
- 1 added fire hydrant
- 2,134 feet of sanitary pipe installation
- Full depth pavement, grading, and storm drainage street improvements on Nuce Road, Marma Drive, Northgate Drive, and Dan Emmett Park Drive







Northside Redevelopment Project: PY 2022

Park/Recreational Improvements:

- New Playground Equipment
- Upgraded basketball courts
- Newly reconstructed ADA parking lot serving Dan Emmett Elementary School and the Park
- 2,525 ft of sidewalk installed to improve pedestrian access and provide alternative options for transportation
- Jersey Barriers created to provide safe separation between the baseball fields ongoing traffic on Nuce Road



West End Revitalization Project: PY 2024

Reconstruction Project Details:

- Installation of new sanitary sewer lines on Beech Alley and North Adams St (benefiting approximately 1,170 residents in a low-moderate household income area)
- Replacing 4,800 linear feet of sidewalk on both sides of West Sugar St to improve connectivity from the West End Neighborhood to downtown
- Construction of 6 pickleball courts and 1 new basketball court to enhance neighborhood activities in Riverside Park
- Total street reconstruction with stormwater drainage enhancements to reduce flooding

Shade Tree & Beautification Committee and Tree City USA

Since the 1995, the City of Mount Vernon has supported a well-established Shade Tree & Beautification Commission dedicated to enhancing and preserving the community's tree canopy. The Commission leads citywide beautification initiatives and provides shade tree planting and care — all at no cost to homeowners within the designated City Tree Lawn Area.

Over the past 10 years, more than **4,900 trees** have been planted and maintained through the combined efforts of the Shade Tree Commission and Tree City USA partners — and that number continues to grow.
